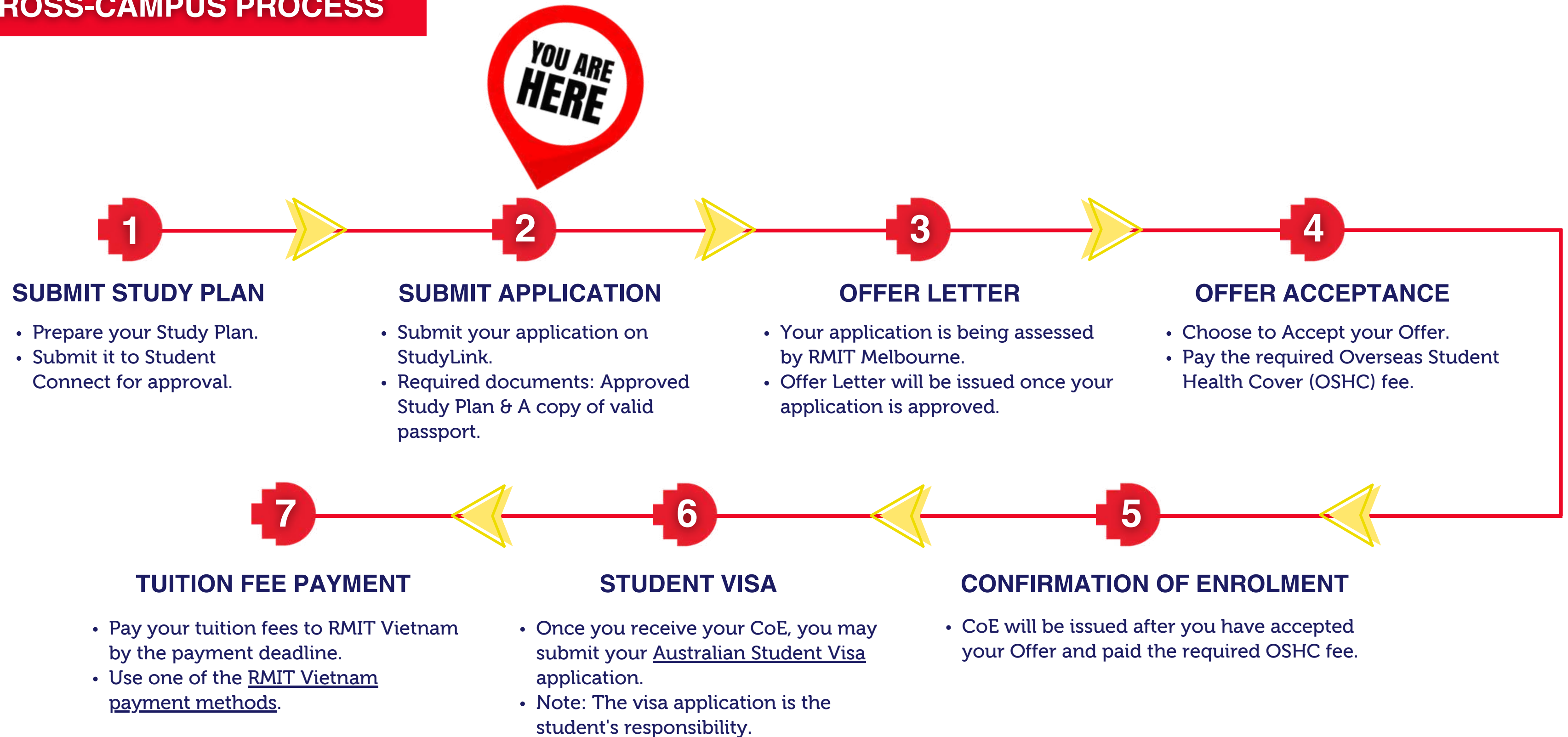

Welcome to your RMIT University International student online application.

Applying to RMIT is easy and should only take about 30 minutes. If you can't finish the application now, you can save your progress and return to it at any time when you are ready to submit it.

To submit a completed application, you will need to:

1. Complete all mandatory (*) questions.

- You will be asked to submit supporting documentation.
- During the application process, you can save this application at anytime and complete this when you have the required documents.

2. Attach your supporting documents. This may include:

- Academic transcripts in both original language and official/accredited English language translation;
- Graduation/completion certificates in both original language and official/accredited English language translation;
- Grading system description/key to grades;
- Course syllabus (subject outline) if you are seeking credit/advanced standing;
- Statement of activities and/or Curriculum vitae (CV)/resume detailing your education history and work experience if your previous qualifications were completed more than 12 months ago;
- Selection task if required for your program;
- [Evidence of English language proficiency](#);
- Biographic (photo) page of your passport (if available);
- An Australian visa grant letter (if applicable).

Your documents must be [certified](#) and posted to RMIT University (where required)

Please note that documents submitted will not be returned.

3. Upload files.

- Each file should be no more than 20 MB. Larger files may time out while uploading and be corrupted.
- File sharing websites such as Dropbox or Google are not recommended as we may experience difficulties accessing your file.
- If you are providing videos, we recommend you upload them to a site like YouTube or Vimeo and provide us with the link

4. When you have completed the application, please check that the information you have provided is correct. You will then be asked to submit your application.

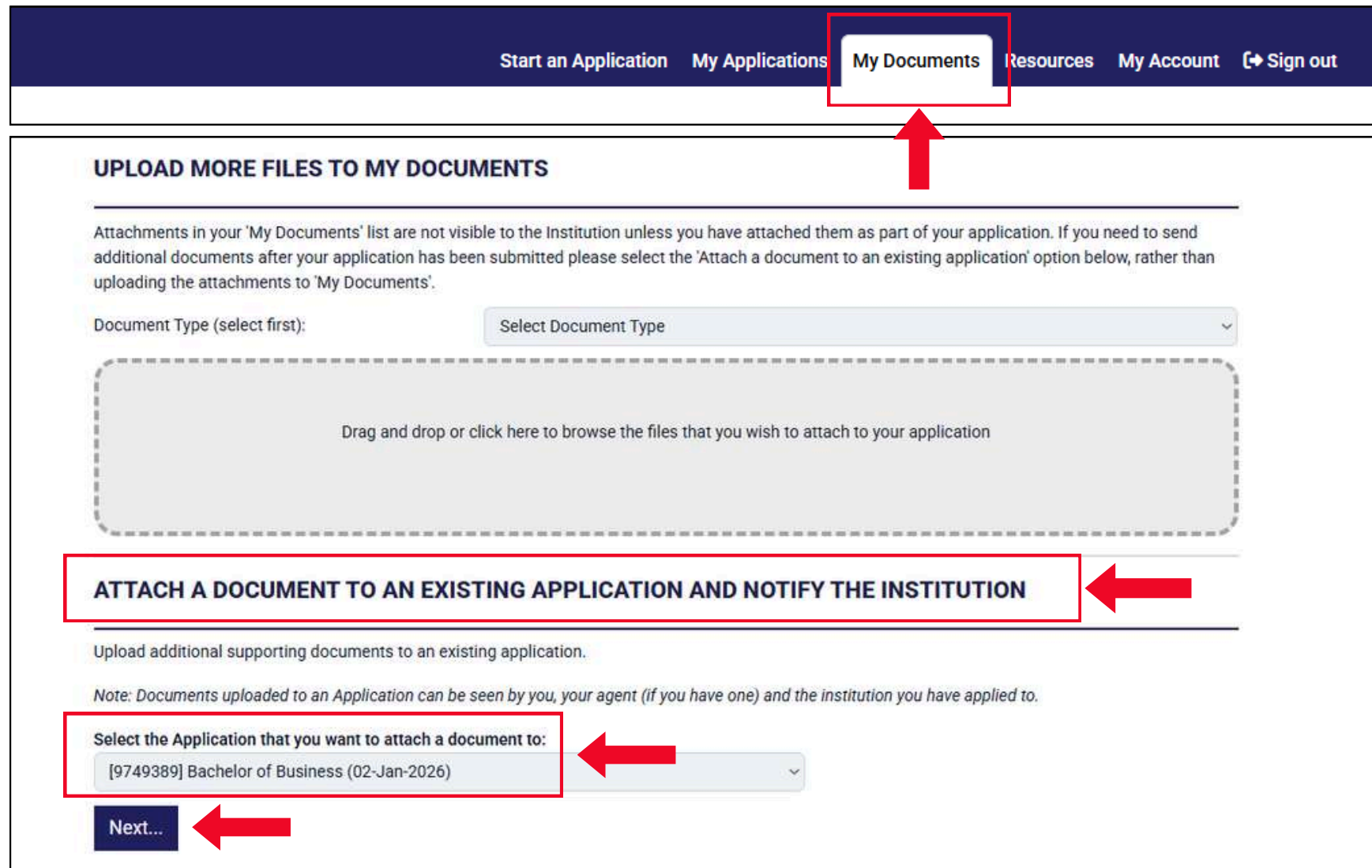

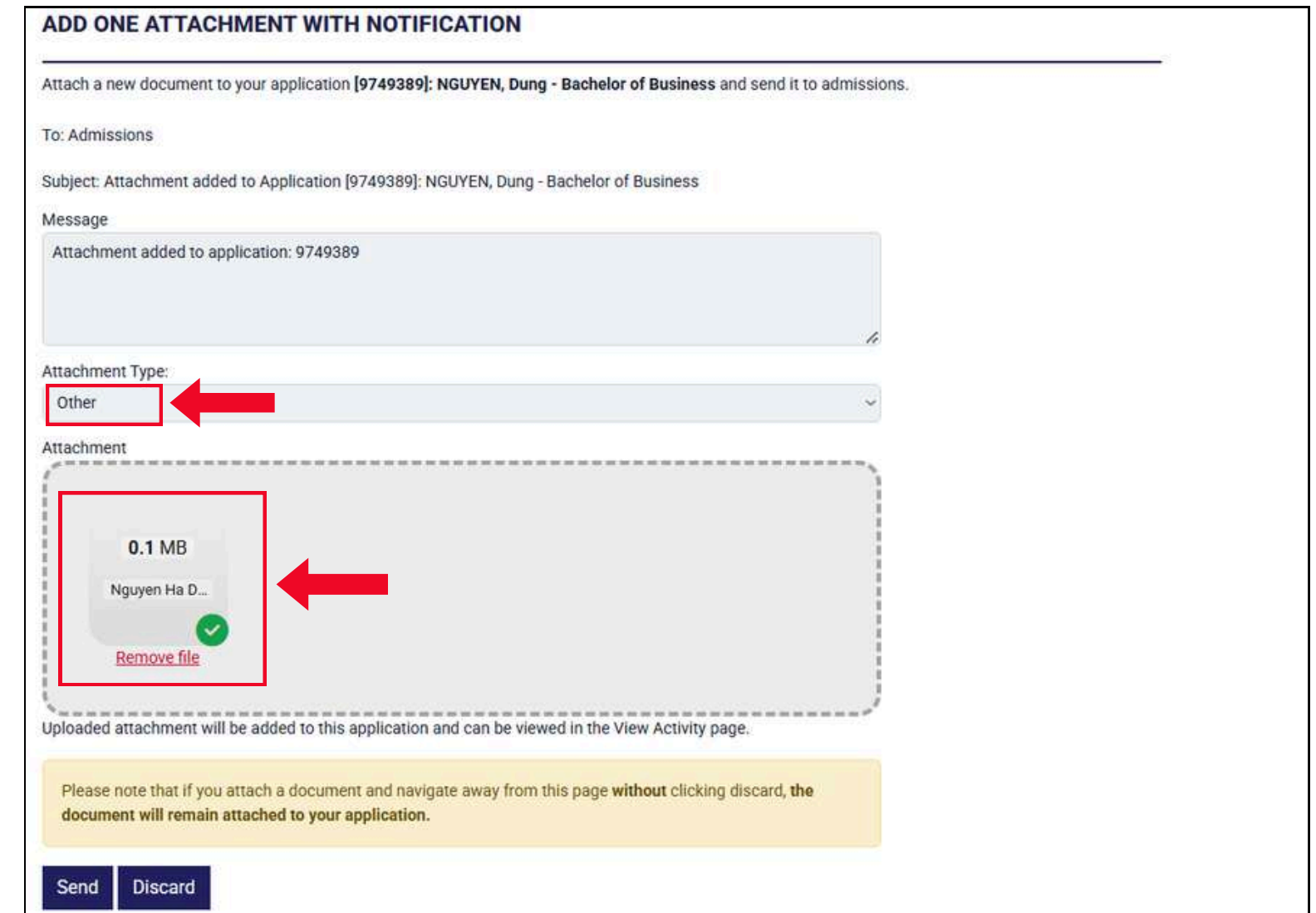

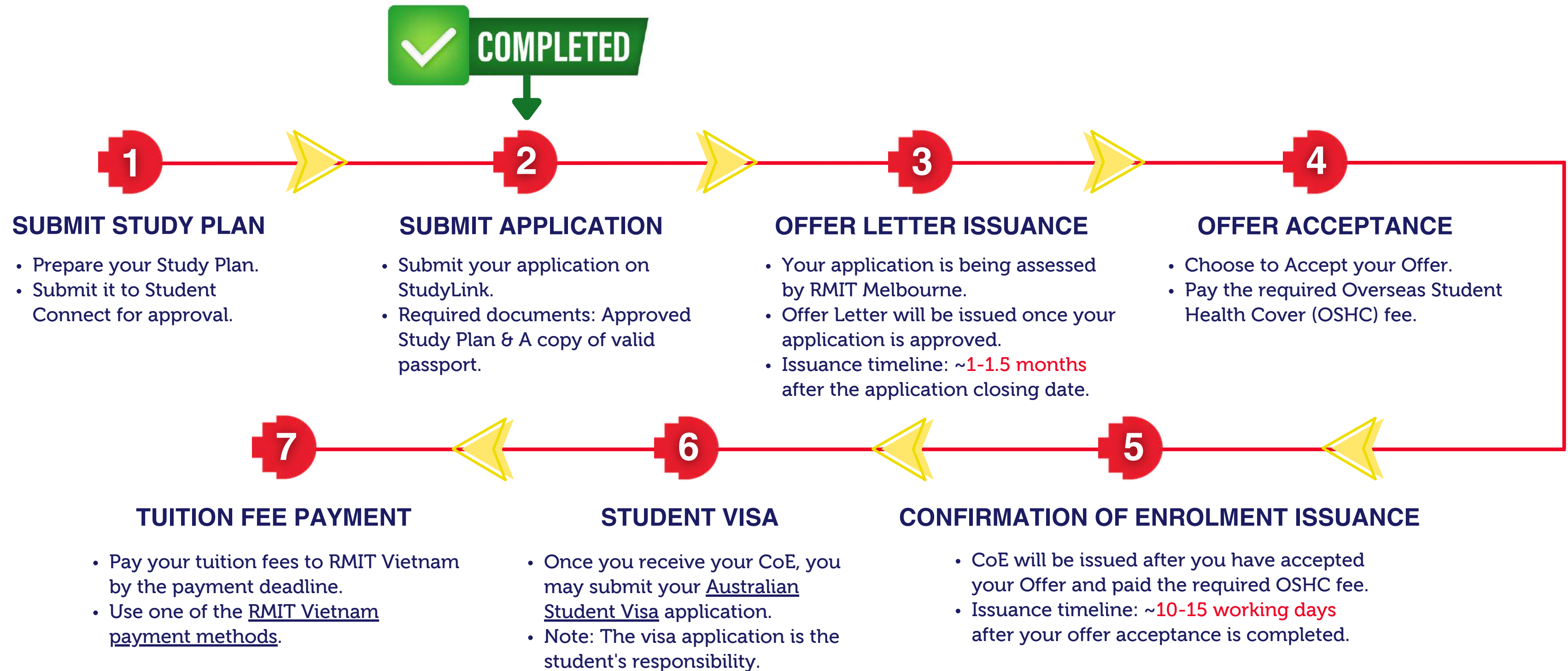
Estimated Offer issuance timeline:
