Instructions

The study plan is to approve courses which are eligible for credit towards your RMIT program. It is **your responsibility** to ensure that the courses you study on your Global Experience are credited to your RMIT degree. Please seek academic advice about your program from one of the following:

- **RMIT Australia students** - Your **RMIT Program Manager/Advisor**
 - ◊ **College of Business students** - **Business Connect**
- **RMIT Vietnam or RMIT SIM students** - **RMIT Connect**

Steps

1. Research courses at your host institution and gather course information
2. List preferred courses on your study plan next to your RMIT course equivalents, then read and the **Student Approval** section
 - ◊ Please contact the **Global Experiences** if you require additional course information from the host institution
3. Attach and submit your course information and study plan to a [RMIT Connect Online enquiry](#) (Student Exchange Programs > Make an Enquiry > Submit a study plan)
4. When the signed and approved study plan is returned to you, please upload it to [your Mobi application](#)
5. If applying for 2 semesters, you must complete one Study Plan per semester
