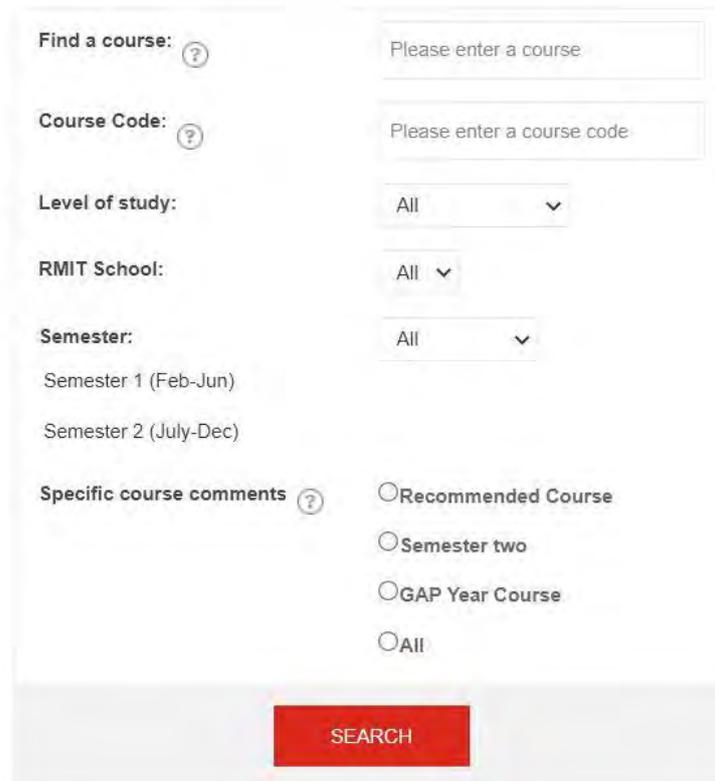
Study Plan Guide

Step 1: Choose remaining courses at RMIT Vietnam

- Go to the [Online enrolment system \(OES\)](#)
- Choose courses you have not studied and have not planned to study at RMIT Vietnam until Cross-Campus semester(s).
- Provide 6 to 8 courses each semester to ensure you have sufficient back-up options.
- It is highly recommended to save your general electives (GE).
- Introduction, contextual and core courses are easier to find equivalents than final-year or project-based courses.

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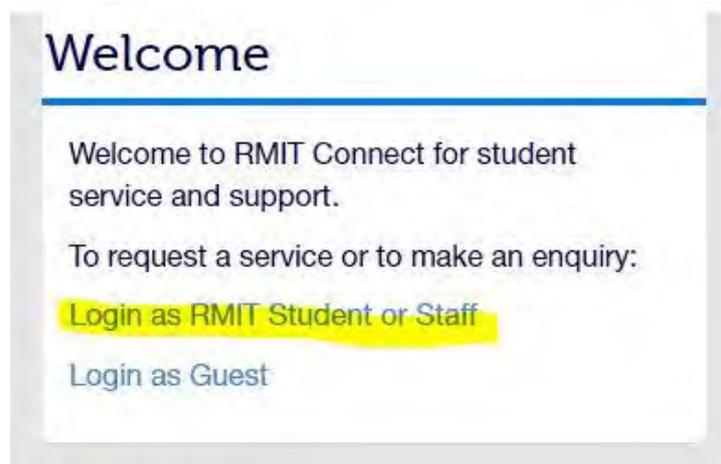

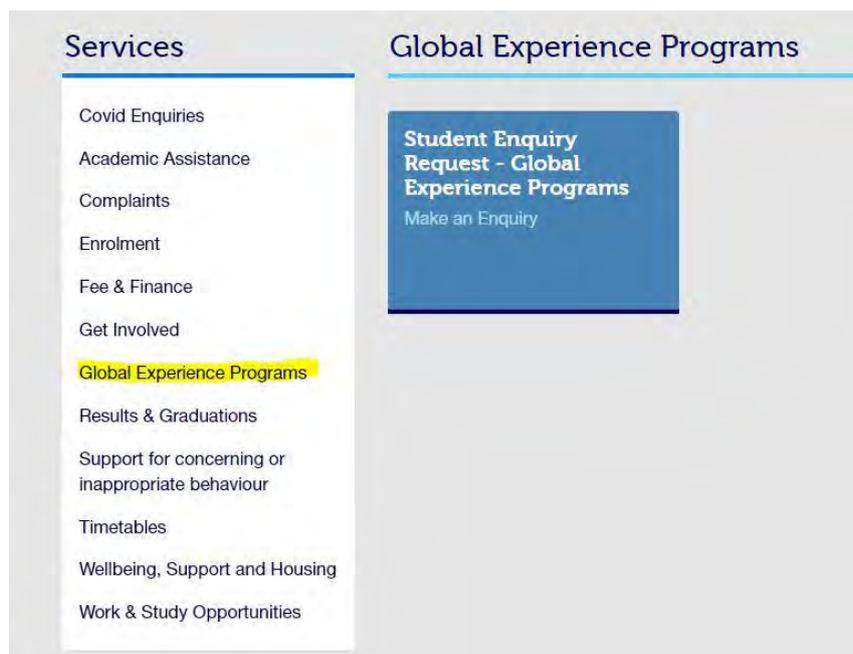
