

RMIT Student Leadership Recognition Award FAQs

1. Why should I apply for RMIT Student Leadership Recognition Award?

For the last eight years, Student Leadership Recognition Awards (SLRAs) have been awarded to some of the most prominent RMIT students who have shown outstanding leadership, and contributed to RMIT community. RMIT SLRAs have opened pathways to help these RMIT students unlock their full potential. This year, the Student Leadership Recognition Awards will be awarded to students who have demonstrated exemplary leadership skills in the areas of social responsibility and service to the RMIT community.

The RMIT SLRA can accompany your degree and you will have an opportunity to win a trip attending the 9th University Scholars Symposium 2018 on 1-7 August 2018 in Bangkok, Thailand. For more information related to the Symposium, you can visit here.

2. How many awards are there?

This year, there are a total of 10 Awards available for all RMIT students. *Top 3*:

- Certificate & gift presented by the President of RMIT Vietnam.
- Ticket to attend the 9th University Scholars Leadership Symposium in Bangkok, Thailand to network with more than 1000 youth leaders from top universities all around the world including Harvard, Yale, Cambridge, Oxford, etc. (click here for more info).
- Two-way airfares to Bangkok and accommodation during the Symposium
- Invitation to attend Student Life End of the Year Thank You Party.

Top 7:

- Certificate & gift presented by the President of RMIT Vietnam.
- Invitation to attend Student Life End of the Year Thank You Party.

3. When is the application deadline?

The application deadline is 11:59 p.m., July 5, 2018 with all supplementary documents.

3. Where can I pick up and drop off the application?

Please submit your 2018 RMIT SLRA Application online. Supplementary documents include:

1. Your resume including extracurricular activities, supporting certificates/evidence/contact for reference.

- 2. 02 letters of recommendation that support and demonstrate your leadership qualities, from your supervisors **OR** your colleagues.
- *Participation in national or international competitions and activities outside of RMIT will all be given credits.
- *All documents need to be condensed on **01** .zip **OR** .rar file and submitted no later than **11:59 PM** on Thursday, **5** July **2018** via *bit.ly/slra2018*.

4. How do I know that I am qualified for the RMIT SLRA?

If you meet the application criteria, you will be considered for the award and you will be notified via email within **one week** after the deadline. **Up to 10 selected recipients will be contacted.**

Note: If you have the prerequisites to receive the RMIT SLRA, but have not been chosen as a recipient for this semester, we encourage you to re-apply next semester and continue with your involvement in leadership and other co-curricular activities.

5. Who reviews the applications?

A selection committee called the Student Leadership Recognition Award Adjudication Committee will review the applications.
