1 Campus address

This is the address of the campus you are studying from

2 Debit Note

This is the number of this debit note

3 Student number

This is your student number

4 Billing period

This is the semester this billing period covers. This includes new and overdue charges.

5 Date of issue

This is the date of issue of this debit note

6 Opening balance

This is the total amount due on your previous debit note

7 Adjustments since previous debit note

This may include (but is not limited to) any charges that have been credited to your account for this billing period because you have dropped a class, or another charge has been reversed.

8 New charges
