Dual campus program options

Students who successfully complete all approved courses in the pathways (with a minimum GPA required and no fails in any course) will be eligible to transfer to the same program at RMIT Melbourne.

Depending on the program you choose, you will have a choice of study options:

3-year Bachelor programs:

1 year at RMIT Vietnam and 2 years at RMIT Melbourne

4-year Bachelor programs:

1 year at RMIT Vietnam and 3 years at RMIT Melbourne

2-year Master programs:

0.5 - 1 year at RMIT Vietnam and 1 - 1.5 years at RMIT Melbourne

You could start at RMIT Vietnam in February, June or October intakes and, depending on the program and option you choose, commence at RMIT Melbourne in February or July intakes.
