Rent	\$250 - \$600
Food	\$200 - \$300
Utilities	\$50 - \$100
Transportation	\$50 - \$70

Free airport pick-up service upon your arrival in Vietnam




Complimentary international student activities: welcome dinner, city tour, cultural discovery trips, cooking classes, ceramic/mosaic workshops
