Introduction

English for Teens at RMIT is an exciting English program designed for young learners aged 12 to 17. Students will be able to develop English, knowledge and soft skills in an international university environment.

The English programs at RMIT Vietnam have been accredited by NEAS - Australia's prestigious English language teaching quality assurance system.



What will you get?

Developing thinking and academic skills

In addition to developing their English skills, students on the English for Teens courses will be introduced to valuable thinking and academic skills. This will help them to prepare for their future higher education.

Students will develop their research, presentation, problem-solving, critical thinking, teamwork and leadership skills. Additionally, they will learn about the importance of academic integrity and avoiding plagiarism.



What will you get?

Project-based learning & assessment

Students will work together on projects during the course. These learner-centred projects require students to work on real world tasks using English. The projects are based on the textbooks so they provide students with the opportunity to use the course language in purposeful ways.

Students are assessed on the development process and on the final product, presentation or performance. The final product may consist of student-produced videos, websites, posters and/or presentations.

With at least two (02) projects each course, students will develop their abilities to apply English to the real world outside their classrooms.



What will you get?

Purposeful use of technology

Students will be facilitated in their use of technology on the English for Teens course. Students have access to online workbooks to independently develop their language skills outside of class. They will also be supported in using technology as part of their projects. This will include the use of digital presentation and poster tools, such as Sway and Google Slides. Additionally, teachers will use digital tools, such as Quizlet and Kahoot, as part of class to engage and motivate learners.

Modern international university environment


Student can access the University's modern library with thousands of books on a wide range of disciplines. It also has many graded readers which are designed for language learners.



Ready for IELTS Test & international university

The eight levels of the English for Teens Program are approximately equivalent to IELTS bands. A student completing all levels of the English for Teens Program should have an English proficiency approximately equivalent to an IELTS score of 7.0 or higher.

From the Advanced level, students will begin focusing on IELTS test preparation and using an IELTS textbook. They will also complete one IELTS mock exam per module.



Who will you study with?

Students will study with RMIT's native-level English teachers whose international teaching qualifications comply with RMIT global standards and who have at least 3 years of experience. In addition, English for Teens has been accredited by NEAS - Australia's prestigious English language teaching quality assurance system. Thus, students will study in an environment that maximizes their English language development in Vietnam. At RMIT. our teachers use communicative teaching methods. interact with learners, put learners at the center of their classes, and build knowledge through project development. Learning from well-qualified teachers experienced in preparing students for success at RMIT University, they will be equipped with the necessary academic skills and advantages straight out of high school.

Course structure

English for Teens at RMIT includes:

- 8 levels, from Elementary to Proficiency
- Each level is divided into 2 modules (A&B) of 60 hours each
- Each module includes 3 soft skills workshops
- Advanced, Advanced Plus and Proficiency levels have an inbuilt component of IELTS test preparation and use IELTS textbooks. Each module also includes a full IELTS practice test.

Assessment

Each module includes:

- 3-4 unit quizzes.
- 2-3 projects.
- End of course assessment.

Parents will be updated on overall performance mid-course and end of course.



English placement test

We offer English placement tests to find the correct level for you. The test includes writing and speaking and is conducted by RMIT English teachers.



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
